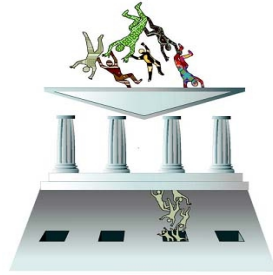

How Are We Doing? Assessing How Advocacy Organizations Account for Victim Safety and Autonomy

Rural advocates work to make positive change within institutions, such as the criminal justice system, whose policies and practices negatively impact victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, stalking and dating violence. Additionally, as advocacy has become more established, our own organizations also greatly benefit from assessments of how practices and policies impact our goals in working with victims. This advanced advocacy training course will teach rural advocates how to recognize features of systems and organizations that adversely affect victims and how to transform or minimize their impact.
