Does your community have an issue you're struggling with?

Praxis staff and technical assistance partners can work with you to organize a video conference training or consultation specific to the needs of your organization, interagency team or community. We can help you think through an issue your community is struggling with or arrange to have an expert train your staff and community partners on a topic specific to your needs via one-to-one video conference. Organizing a video consultation is a practical and inexpensive way of bringing national experts directly to your community.

Grantees have received help on issues such as:

- Maximizing your Coordinated Community Response to create systems change
- Protocol development for law enforcement response
- Training your collaborative teams about the impact of a batterer's violence on children
- Incorporating the voices of battered women into policy, curriculum development and program evaluation



This is a great way to bring your community partners together for training and problem-solving!

- Approved assistance: Rural grantees do not need to receive prior approval from their OVW program specialist to access this assistance.
- Video conference expenses for Rural grantees can be covered with your OVW set-aside funds.
- Praxis staff & TAPs will work with you around all of the content and technical details of hosting a video conference.
